

Remote workers could expose firms to data breach risk

BI's Article search uses Boolean search capabilities. If you are not familiar with these principles, here are some quick tips.

To search specifically for more than one word, put the search term in quotation marks. For example, "workers compensation". This will limit your search to that combination of words.

To search for a combination of terms, use quotations and the & symbol. For example, "hurricane" & "loss".

Research by U.K.-based consultancy Theta Global Advisors LLP found that more than 55% of IT decision makers feel remote workers could expose their firm to the risk of a data breach, Captive International reported. Chris Biggs, a partner at Theta, said that businesses should invest in upgrading their cybersecurity protection as reported cyberattack cases have increased amid the COVID-19 pandemic.
